

## **Exploration Geophysicist**

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) currently regulates petroleum-related activities in the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Area on behalf of the federal and provincial governments. Legislation currently before Parliament will be mirrored by the provincial government next year to expand our mandate to include offshore renewable energy projects as the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Energy Regulator (C-NLOER).

The C-NLOPB (soon to be the C-NLOER) provides regulatory oversight of the offshore energy sector in the areas of health and safety, environmental protection, resource management and Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador benefits.

The C-NLOPB invites applications for the position of **Exploration Geophysicist**. Reporting to the Exploration Geoscience Lead in the Exploration and Information Resources department, this position will:

- Evaluate and interpret 2D and 3D seismic data
- Participate in geophysical studies and special projects related to petroleum exploration and renewable energy geosciences
- Conduct geophysical interpretation in support of land tenure assessments
- Administer regulations and guidelines for exploration related approvals and authorizations; monitor operators' activities for compliance with approvals; and communicate with operators with respect to compliance
- Participate in drafting and review of exploration related policies, guidance and other regulatory instruments
- Provide geophysical advice and support to other departments
- Liaise with energy companies, external stakeholders and consultants
- Other related duties assigned as required

Applicants should have at least five years' experience in the petroleum industry and must possess a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in Geology or Geophysics. Eligibility for registration with the Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Newfoundland and Labrador (PEGNL) is required. The ideal candidate has a strong understanding of sedimentary geological processes with an overall focus on energy sector geophysical analyses. Experience with 2D/3D seismic data interpretation and knowledge of advanced geophysical techniques is required.
