The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB), in consultation with the Board's fishery and environmental review agencies, has reviewed the *West White Rose Project Environmental Assessment Drill Cuttings Amendment* (Cenovus Energy April 11, 2023) submitted to assess the effects of discharging synthetic-based mud (SBM) cuttings.

The Environmental Assessment (EA) Amendment and Cenovus' responses to reviewer comments provide a satisfactory assessment of environmental effects associated with this activity.
